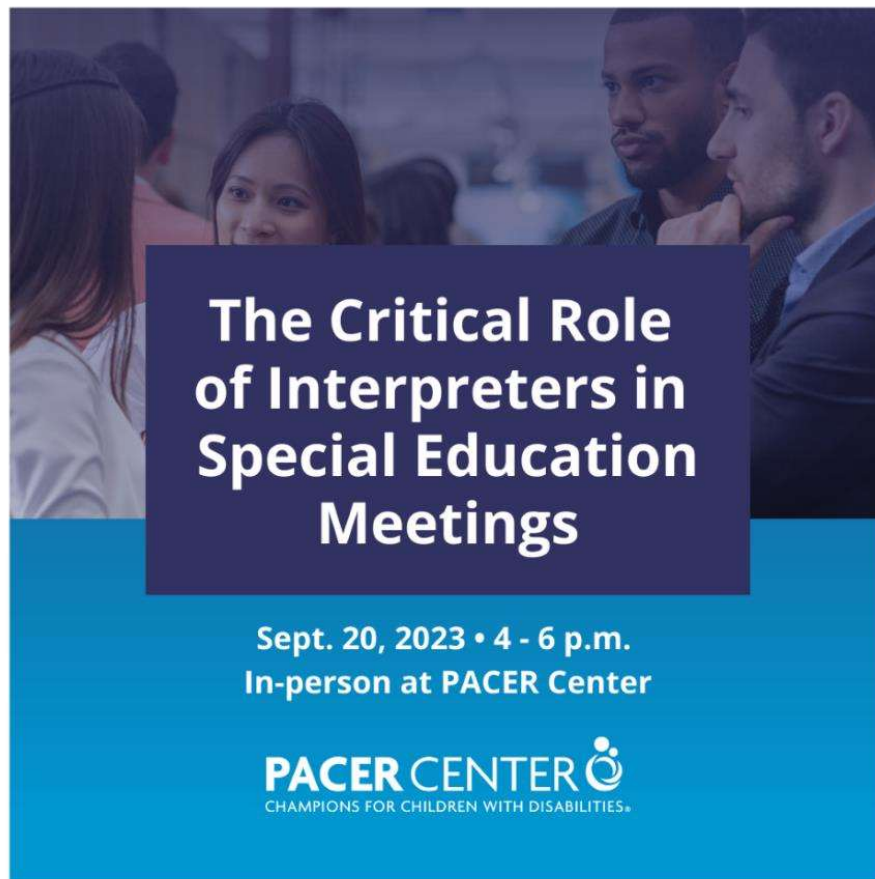
The Critical Role of Interpreters in Special Education Meetings
